

**\$925** **'s Left Ankle Fractures and Gross Deformity**

Open fracture of medial malleolus, also involving posterior malleolus. Dislocation of ankle joint. Fracture of lateral malleolus.

**\$925** **'s 6/30/07 Right Foot Injury**

Comminuted fracture of tibia (proximal tibia). Open fracture wound. Comminuted fracture distally with medial displacement. Displaced comminuted fracture of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th metatarsals distally. Loss of bone along medial aspect of 1st MPJ joint.

**\$925** **'s Chronic Left Shoulder Condition**

Obvious deformity of acromioclavicular joint. Nonunion of distal clavicle fracture. Grade 2 AC joint sprain. Rotator cuff tendinopathy. Impingement syndrome. Rheumatoid arthritis.

**\$1095** **'s Left Hand Injuries**

Small finger carpometacarpal joint dislocation. Thumb dislocated at carpometacarpal joint. Small finger carpometacarpal joint dislocation. Thumb dislocated at carpometacarpal joint. Comminuted fracture at base of fourth metacarpal.

**\$1095** **'s Traumatic Leg Injuries**

Tibia. Fibula. Closed tibia fracture. Closed fibula fracture. Deformity of left ankle and foot. Open tibia fracture. Open fibula fracture. Open 1.4 metatarsal fractures. Open 1st proximal phalanx and 5th middle phalanx fractures. Dark brown discoloration along dorsal aspect of 1st and 2nd toes. Torn tissue due to interosseous muscles on plantar surface.

**\$1095** **'s Left Forearm Injuries**

Open comminuted fracture of the proximal one third of the ulna. Distal fracture fragments overriding the proximal by 1 cm. Fracture dislocated proximally. Normal articulation of radius. Abnormal ulnar articulation (rotated).

**\$1095** **'s Skull Injury: January 20-22, 2009 CT**

Fractures of bilateral orbits. Disruption of base ethmoidal. Fractures of orbital wall. Comminuted nasal and ethmoid bone fractures. Frontal lobe contusion. Vascular injury in right eye. Large amount of blood blocking vision. Indistinct basal ganglia. Inferior basal ganglia. Fracture involving right sphenoid chamber. Disruption of base ethmoidal. Disruption of base ethmoidal. Disruption of base ethmoidal. Fracture fragments entrapped on orbit and inferior orbital base fractures. Complete vision loss. B-Bell typeface. Disruption of globe with vitreous hemorrhage. Left orbital blowout fracture with inferior herniation. Minimally displaced fractures with anterior maxillary sinus.

**\$1195** **'s 4/8/10 CT Scans**

Axial Section. Coronal Section. Displaced fracture of right frontal sinus. Subdural hematoma. Cerebral contusion. Skull vault fracture with hemorrhage. Fracture involving right sphenoid chamber. Soft tissue swelling, hematoma and air. Right anterior frontal cortical contusion. Hematoma involving right frontotemporal soft tissues. Multiple comminuted fractures of the right zygomatic arch with innumerable fracture fragments. Displacement of multiple fracture fragments into orbit, with surrounding hematoma. Optic nerve injury. Displacement of anterior and lateral walls of the right maxillary sinus.

**\$1195** **'s Permanent Brain Injury: 6/14/11 MRI**

Chronic multifocal bilateral hemorrhagic contusion of frontal lobes with frank encephalomalacia. Hemorrhagic traumatic axonal injury. Encephalomalacia. Glosis. Hemosiderin deposits.
